Keep Walking

This is a plea for you to continue to set the example for me and the everyone else to follow. Keep walking through the Valley. There is a lot of truth in Psalm 23 in that we do walk through the valley of the shadow of death. Death is the hard reality that this time on earth is very limited and rather unpredictable – 2 Peter 1:14 & Matt 24:40-41. And let's not forget hard. It can very hard indeed. And it varies for everyone. The hurdles in the valley are relational, spiritual, physical health, isolation, just living a Biblical, counter-cultural lifestyle. The depth and diversity of each of these hurdles is significant. Your walk is critical. As you navigate your way through the valley, people are watching: your peers, your family, your kids, and your neighbors. I am watching as I need role-models and examples to follow. We do not do this alone and examples and role-models are necessary. Keep walking. Psalm 23 make this walk plainly evident. However it does not leave you in the valley without hope. The walk "through" suggests there is another side and we will make it through. But maybe the most important hopeful fact is that He is with us.

"He makes me lie down in green pastures; **He** leads me beside quiet waters.
He restores my soul; **He** guides me in the paths of righteousness For **His** name's sake."

Jesus walks with us, so keep walking. We need your example! We need the example of others electing to live their lives against the contemporary ideas of culture, like choosing a Christian school that charges tuition, like tithing in the offering plate, like voting pro-life, like getting out of bed on Sunday morning to sit in the pew. Keep walking. We need others fighting health issues: fighting through cancer, fighting through the medical system to get the necessary care, fighting to see friends and family in the hospital or nursing home, or to see shut-ins, wrestling through hospice, grieving a death. Keep walking. We need young people fighting to live their faith in the face of MASSIVE cultural apathy within their generation. Keep walking. We need strong leaders living the example of evidential, observational faith even when they feel like the only one on the island. Keep walking. Your kids need this. Your neighbors need this. Your village needs this. Keep walking the faith through the valley. Jesus is there to help. It will be hard. But there are green pastures, quiet waters, and paths of righteousness. There is restoration. His goodness and lovingkindness are there for your walk. We need your example. We are praying for your strength to endure. Keep walking – God bless your steps!!!
