However, I will argue that the more important part of the "IN" crowd according to Romans 8 is not the "IN" at all. It is "Christ." It is only Christ that removes the subjectivity. Christ is objective, historic, and transformative. It is only "IN CHRIST" that we can obtain all that we could ever need and certainly more than we can even imagine – Eph 3:20. We are not guaranteed any degree of success outside of Christ. So it is not just any crowd that will do. It is only the crowd of Christ = Church. What an amazing gift to know where to find the "IN Crowd"! It is "IN" Church that we learn of the Grace that makes this all a reality.
